DIALOGUE

- Write a back and forth argument between two characters without any mentions of their names and dialogue tags; try and focus on making their speech patterns, word choices, and phrases unique, instead of describing them, to the point that by the end of the conversation, readers can tell who's speaking just by the words a character says. Model a simple script, denoting each piece of dialogue as spoken by 'A' or 'B'.

Example:

A: Why did you have to do that?

B: Me? You're the one who got us into this mess in the first place.

This is just an exercise to get you started with strengthening your dialogue writing skills. What conversations you decide to write for your own fiction story is completely up to you.
